SUBJECT: Appointment of new members to the Council for Youth Development

RECOMMENDATION: That the Council for Youth Development (CYD) approves the appointment of Madelene A. Muntz.

BACKGROUND:

Ms. Muntz has a Bachelor of Science in Special Education from Virginia State University, and a Masters in Human Resource Management and Organizational Development from Chapman University. Her previous employment was the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation from 1986-2007. She retired December 2007 as Chief Deputy Warden.

Ms. Muntz Community Involvement consisted of Principal for a Day Program for Elementary, Middle, and High School Science. She established a program for at-risk high school females to attend the Governor's Conference for Women and secured financial support from local civic organizations and unions to support the program. She volunteered in local GED, resume, interviewing skills programs; facilitated Alternatives to Violence Programs; taught Conflict Management Resolution; and, established the Breakfast with Santa Program. Ms. Muntz maintained memberships in Soroptimist, Rotary, NAACP, Links, Inc., Associations of Black and Chicano Correctional Workers. She is a member of California Democratic Party Disabilities Caucus, and African-American Caucus.
