Partner Meetings- Current topics, roles and responsibilities of partnership, support of AJCC, CQI updates and observations

- Hosted monthly MOU Partner/BET Meetings at all locations (Riverside, Hemet and Indio) for January, completed meetings for Riverside and Hemet thus far.
- Agencies shared an interest in wanting to learn how to navigate the CalJobs Event Manager. Now have enough interest and next steps will be to complete a webinar with more information on how to navigate via Event Manager.
- Partners were also introduced to using the SharePoint feature to retrieve information shared at partner meetings and to share information and resources that other partners wish to share with others. Demonstrations will follow.

- Based on responses from the AJCC Partner Survey, there will be a WIOA/Career Resource Area (CRA) training held for all partners to attend to learn more about WIOA and how customers are introduced to services once they arrive in the CRA. Training is set for March 16th, 2020 at 9:00am at 1325 Spruce St; Riverside CA.
- Many partners have completed their page set-up within the Connect I.E. website, but there are still a few that need to complete. Once many have completed their page set-up, will invite Edward Ramirez from IEHP to provide next steps in moving forward with the referral process.

CQI – Conduct observations at AJCCs (Hemet, Riverside, and Indio)

- One Stop Operator conducted observations at the Career Resource Area- Conduct Job seeker/staff interaction in the Career Resource Areas, job seeker assistance as well as within workshops for the month of January, and in the process of completing observations for February.
- Reviewed AJCC TV monitoring system to see if all was current with hiring events, current job openings, labor market information on an ongoing basis.

Update MOU partners with most recent LMI reports and data including but not limited to:

- Provided Partners with the most recent EDD Labor Market Information Monthly Report for Riverside County.
- Checked to see if the AJCC TV Scrolling message located in the CRA was updated with current LMI reports.
- Target industry information and related occupations updated and discussed with partners. Awaiting direction from Title I management on how to implement new target industries.

Special Projects

- Initially introduced MOU partners on the 5th and 10th of December to Connect IE, the web-based software that will be used for referring customers to services provided by MOU partners. Edward Ramirez, from IEHP came out to give a presentation and did a live demo of how the system works. Updates will continue once referral system is up and running.
- Requested all MOU AJCC partners to complete an agency “Fact Sheet” on their agency to share of their services. Currently in the process of completing an electronic guide that will also be printable.
- Partners soon to receive access to RivCo SharePoint to retrieve information discussed at partner meetings, activities and events hosted by outside partners, Job/Resource Fairs, etc.

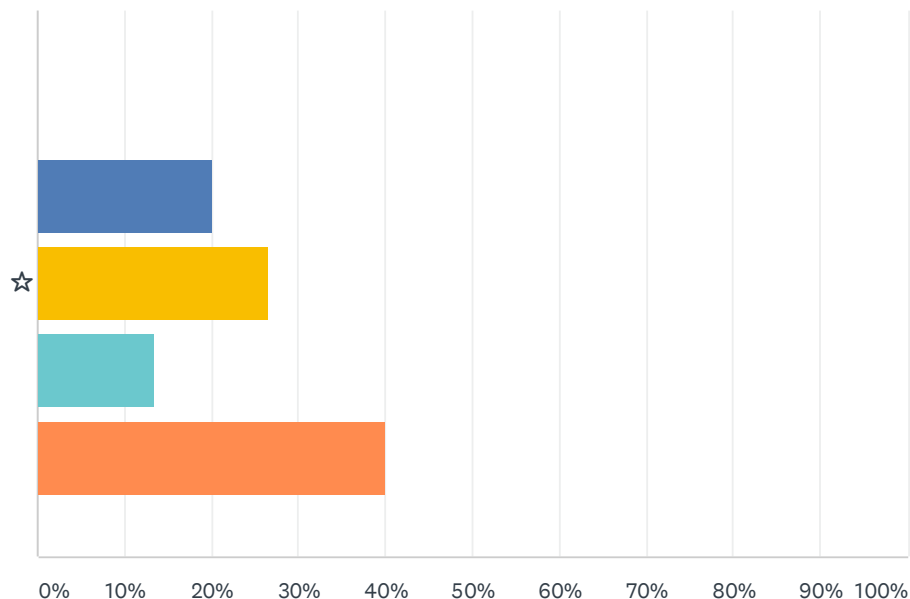

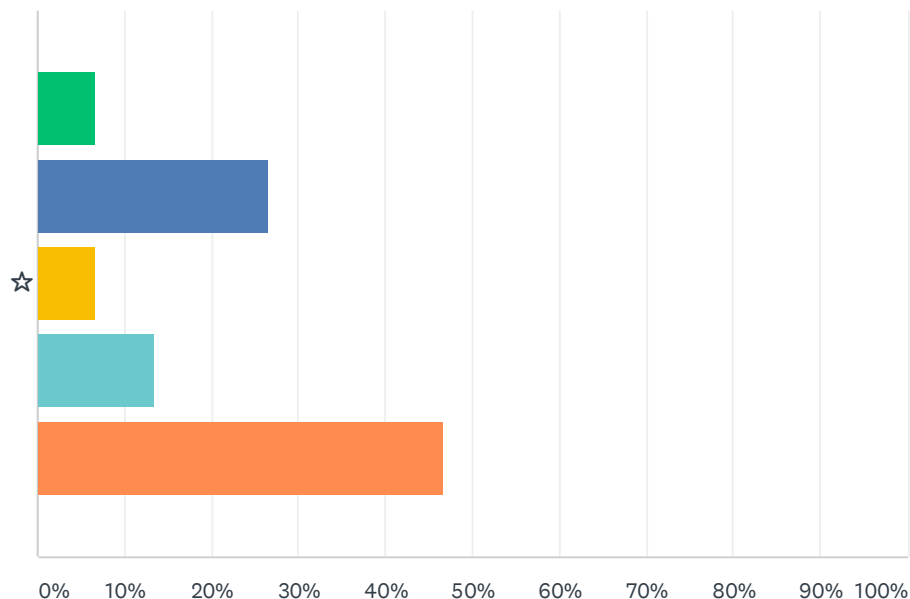

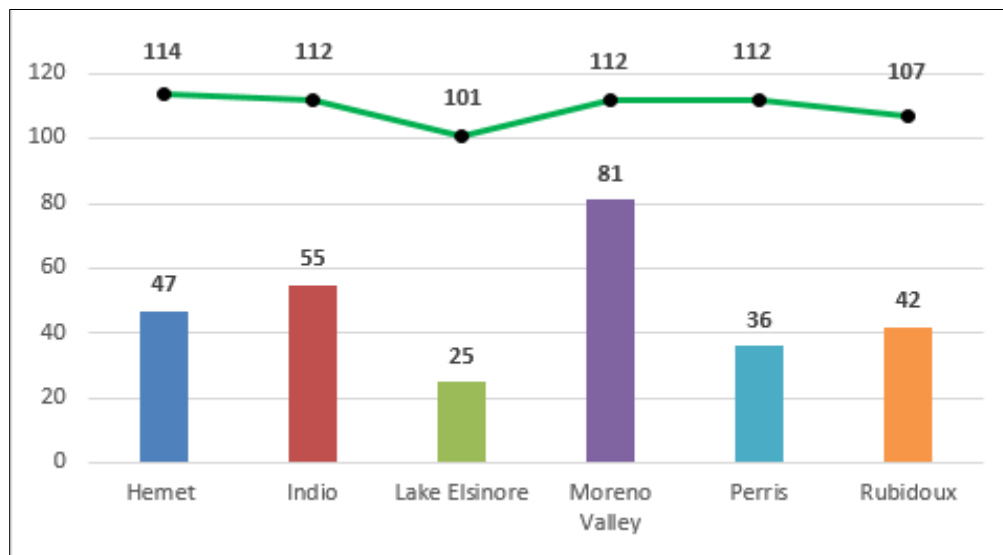
YOUTH OPPORTUNITY CENTER ACTIVITIES December 2019

July 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020



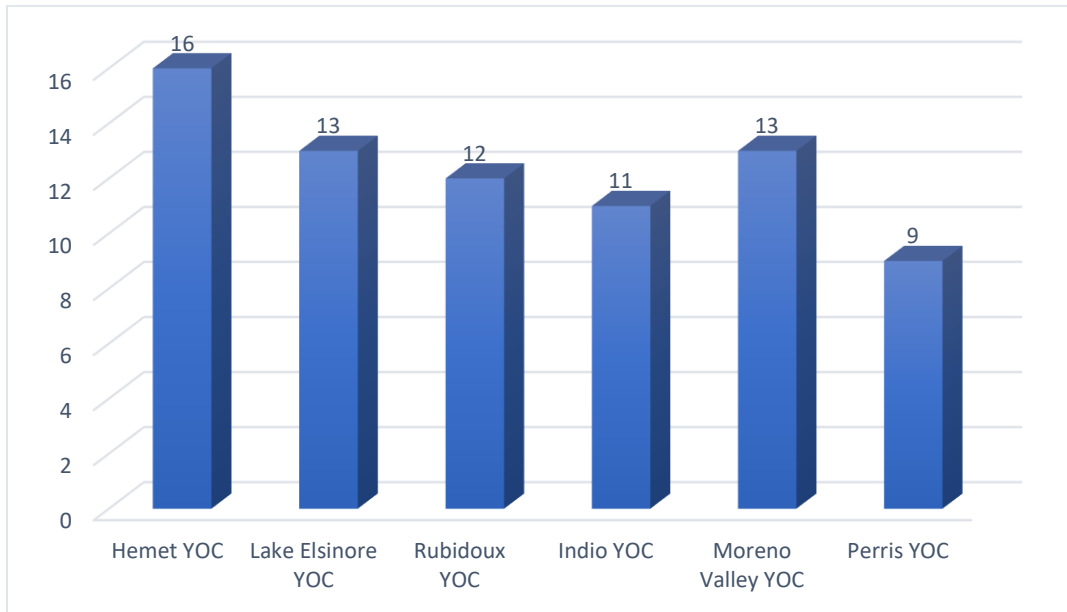
New Enrollments + Active Enrollments from previous program year.

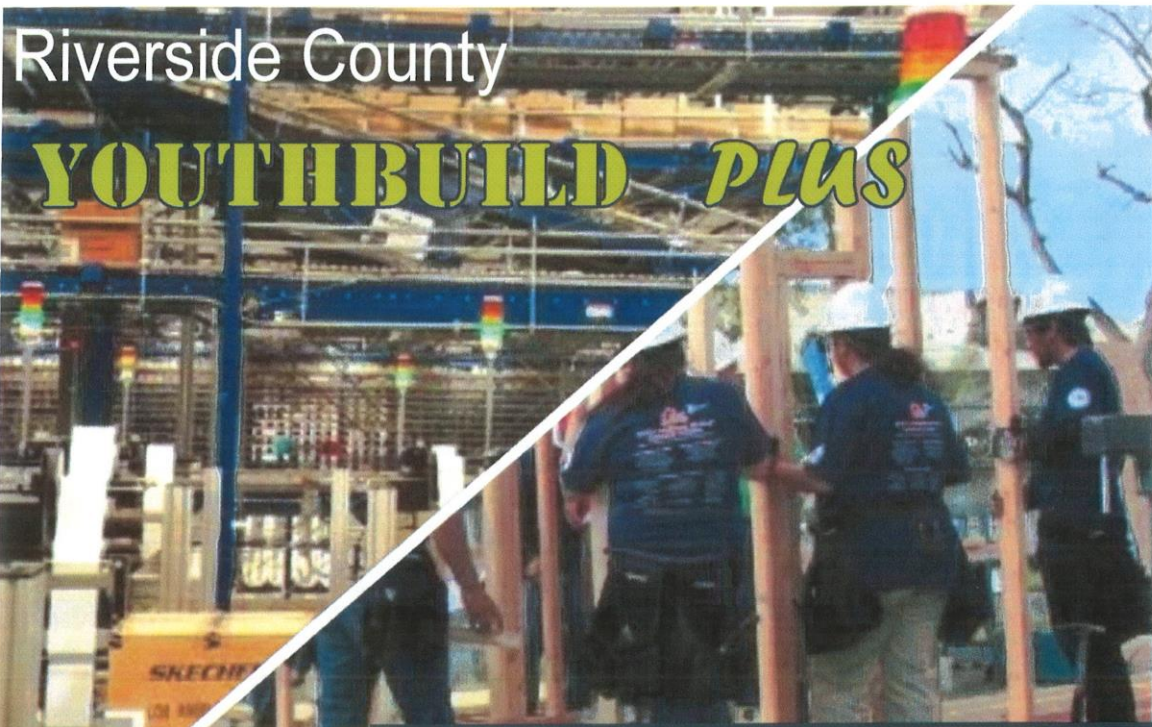

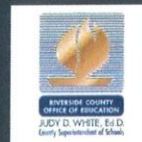
